Friday, November 4th 2022, see's 33-year-old singer-songwriter Wu'ra unveil her much anticipated second single; *More to life*. Widely known for her resonant vocals and storytelling capabilities Wu'ra shines in this return.

3 minutes and 39 seconds is all it takes to be musically transported to a place of complete solitude. *More to life* is a personable song for the times with its release coming at a time when there seems to be a general sense of malaise globally. It presents the listener with the opportunity to escape the day-to-day rhythm of life and enter a world of deep wondering.

The acoustic guitar sets the perfect backdrop for a song that's lyricism is so impactful, you can't help but get lost in thought. With every refrain, the powerhouse vocalist engages the listener with her emotion-evoking cadences and raw softness. A beautifully crafted song that expands Wu'ra artistic motif and is sure to be timeless.

The stripped-back acoustic song was birthed from an honest and open conversation between Wu'ra and Alywin Steele in the Studio. Impressively, in a total of 6 hours, *More to life* was written, recorded and filmed. At the heart of the poignant and melancholy record, the London-based singer says is hope for a happy ending.

“We had an open conversation that got honest too quickly about family, life, being stuck in limbo and questioning what's next. We discussed the current struggles of the living cost crisis and the brutal truths of this path. Ultimately we wrote a song about hope and its relevance in the knowing that deep down inside, this can't be it, and there has to be a happy ending.” - Wu'ra

Since her success on The Voice UK and releasing her debut single; *Fitila*, Wu'ra has been touring the UK with her Rose Gold Elite Choir and making appearances on festival stages with BBC Radio 1 presenters Scott Mills and Chris Stark.
